Thank you for contacting me regarding legislation to reauthorize the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). I appreciate hearing from you.

As you may know, the House of Representatives passed its version of the FAA bill (H.R.2881) on September 20, 2007. The Senate bill (S.1300) passed the Senate Commerce Committee on August 3, 2007, but neither bill has yet been considered by the full Senate.

Like most Americans, I believe that we need to modernize our air travel infrastructure. We need to make major investments in our antiquated system so that the nation's airports can increase their air traffic while functioning safely.

Please be assured that I will continue working to pass legislation that will improve and modernize the FAA without adversely affecting any sector of the aviation community.
